From the East:

- 1. Take I-94W to the Riverside Avenue exit.
- 2. Turn right and follow Riverside Avenue.
- 3. For the green or gold garages, take a right on 25th Avenue South. The green garage will be on your left. The gold garage will be on your right.
- 4. For the red ramp, take a right on 23rd Avenue South and an immediate right onto6th Street South.

From the West:

- 1. Take I-94E to the 25th Avenue exit.
- 2. Turn left and proceed one block to Riverside Avenue.
- 3. For the green and gold garages, proceed straight on 25th Avenue South. The green garage will be on your left. The gold garage will be on your right.
- 4. For the red ramp, take a left onto Riverside Avenue. Take a right on 23rd Avenue South and an immediate right onto 6th Street South.


